Urgent Care Center (UCC) Weekend Closure

When to go to the UCC:

Urgent care is care you need for a non-emergency illness or injury. You need urgent care treatment within 24 hours, and you shouldn't have to travel more than 30 minutes for the care. You typically need urgent care to treat a condition that:

- Doesn't threaten life, limb or eyesight.
- Needs attention before it becomes a serious risk to health.

Examples may include things like a high fever or sprained ankle.

The Nurse Advice Line is available to all TRICARE beneficiaries in the U.S., except those enrolled in the U.S. Family Health Plan.



Call or visit your nearest urgent care facility if you have a non-life threatening health issue. If you have a life-threatening health issue, call 911 immediately.

What should I do if I have a life threatening health issue?

Call 911 immediately to get emergency care if you have a life-threatening health issue.

What should I do if I'm still unsure if I need urgent care?

You can speak directly to a health professional using the Military heath System Nurse Advice Line to assist you with your health concern by calling 1-800-TRICARE (874-2273), option 1.

Does Naval Hospital Pensacola provide emergency care services?

No. Call 911 in case of an emergency.

Does Naval Hospital Pensacola provide urgent care services?

Yes. Call 850-505-6731. Naval Hospital Pensacola's Urgent Care Center is open 7 am to 4 pm, Mon-Fri; closed weekends and federal holidays.
